## OUR BRIT: COVENANT OF CARE

According to our Medical Advisory Task Force, as well as guidance from the CDC and Dallas County Public Health, those who are not vaccinated against Covid-19 are at increased risk of infection to themselves and others, and many conditions, with or without vaccination, are associated with increased risk of infection and worse outcomes of Covid-19 infection. It is safest for all that these individuals experience Temple online. Those who wish to participate in person, and are eligible for vaccination, are required to complete **Our Brit: Covenant of Care** before entering the building:

I affirm the complimentary Jewish values of *sakanat nefashot*, taking precaution to avoid endangering others, and *shmirat haguf*, preserving my own health and well-being. In order to maximize the safety of all people coming into this sacred space, I agree to the following in order to participate in-person at Temple Emanu-El:

- **I am fully vaccinated\***
- I will wear a face mask covering my nose and mouth when in the building
- I will maintain social distance from other congregants who are not members of my own family
- I will stay home if I have an active illness
